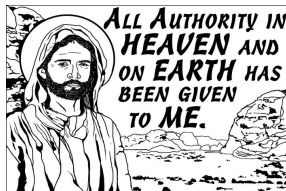

After the 8:30 a.m. Mass, you may go to Gallagher Hall for the opportunity to:

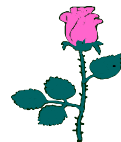
